Vermont Act 120
Vermont Consumer Protection Rule 121
Labeling Foods Produced with Genetic Engineering

[Vermont Act 120](#) defines food in section 3042. (3) as: “Food” means food intended for human consumption.

[Vermont CP Rule 121](#) further defines food in Section 121.01 (5) and additional [guidance](#) provided as:

- Articles used for food and drink for humans
- Chewing gum, and
- Articles used for components of any such article
- Food does not include dietary supplements or drugs
- Definition adapted from U.S. FDA 21 USC 321 (f)

Seventh Generation products are not food as defined in 21 USC 321 (f), nor Vermont Act 120 or Vermont CP Rule 121.

Seventh Generation products are home and personal care products, and are not intended for human consumption, and as such are not subject to the provision of Vermont Act 120 and Vermont CP Rule 121.
